Second meeting of the international selection tender panel Position of Assistant Researcher at LIP

Minutes - March 18 - 19, 2024

These are the minutes of the second meeting of the international selection tender panel for the call of a position of Assistant Researcher to carry out research in the scientific areas of Instrumentation for particle/nuclear physics and technology applications to healthcare and space, as well as computing and information technologies, in the framework of the Agreement - Programme "Procedimento Concursal de Apoio Institucional – Laboratórios Associados" (articles 17, 19 and 28 of the Scientific Employment Regulations - Regulamento do Emprego Científico - REC), signed between FCT and LIP.

The call was open from 22nd January to 5th February 2024, 17:00 (Lisbon time).

The panel meeting took place in-person at the premises of LIP-Lisbon, on 18th and 19th March 2024. The public presentations by the candidates and the private interviews with the panel were held on the same day.

Candidates admitted to the second phase

There were no appeals to the results of the Scientific and Curricular Background (SCB) evaluation carried out in the first phase. The candidates ranked in the first six positions were invited to the public presentation and interview.

Public presentations and interviews

The public presentations took place in person at LIP Lisbon in the morning of March 18, 2024 and were broadcast via zoom. The following candidates presented in alphabetic order (of the first name): Alexandre Lindote, Cláudio Silva, João Gentil, Marco Pinto, Maria Luisa Arruda, Rui Curado Silva.

The private interviews with the panel took place in the same day, in the afternoon, all in person.

Second Panel Meeting

Following the interviews, the panel met and discussed the performance of the candidates in both the presentation and the interviews.

The panel noted that all six candidates exhibited a very high scientific standard, congratulated them for their achievements, and thanked them for the excellent presentations and frank discussions.

The panel members calculated the final score and ranked the candidates approved in both methods by applying the formula defined in the tender. In order to reach a final classification, the panel took into account also the SCB evaluation, listed in table 1 of the minutes of the first meeting.

These Minutes include a summary of all votes casted by each of the jury member and respective reasoning (Annex 1).
